Keith Nordyke was the guest speaker and spoke on a new model aimed to lower the rate of recidivism called TIGER. They are working along with the LSU Sociology Department. The program has 122 questions that involve Risk and Needs Assessment. The current model is called LARNA.

The purpose is to lower mass incarceration by lowering recidivism. From the year 2000 to date, there have been approximately 163,000 releases and 110,000 individuals.

Cammie Maturin spoke about SB 424 and the difficulty of getting the bill off the ground. Senator Martini is sponsoring the bill and has helped Cammie and her efforts.
