### **General Membership Meeting:**

The monthly meeting was a “virtual” meeting conducted on ZOOM. President Checo Yancy welcomed everyone participating and this was followed by a moment of silence.

Checo Yancy asked Secretary Jay Jackson to give an overview of our new PayPal setup with Chase Bank.

Treasurer Avis Henderson gave a treasurer’s report. The two separate accounts (\$1,920.55 & \$2,463.80) were combined in to one account for a balance of \$4384.35.

Checo reviewed a list of some of the bills that are expected to be introduced at the next legislative session.

- Expanding medical parole
- Simplifying parole statutes and eligibility
- Principal accomplice liability
- Calculation of release dates
- Legalize marijuana and expanding the use of medical marijuana
- Clean slate expungement
- Speedy trials
- Solitary confinement study
